

An infinitely variable range of speeds within its high and low ratio limits are obtained without any gear shifting. Drive may


be coupled directly, geared, chained or belt driven according to the unit or application requirement. On the average gasoline engine, speeds are developed from the output shaft varying from 500 rpm "in low" with full torque to 5,000 rpm "in high". Normal overall range of ratios is from 4 to 1. Final reductions of from 50 to 1 "in high" to 200 to 1 "in low" are available.

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



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

TO MOUNT SHEAVE OR SPROCKET

IMPORTANT—Be sure tapered cone surface of clutch hub and inside of sheave or sprocket hub are free of all foreign substances such as paint, grease or dirt. Wipe surfaces with a clean cloth moistened with a light grade of machine oil (about SAE 20). This will permit a more uniform draw and prevent cone surfaces from freezing before being properly tightened.

- Slide large end of sheave or sprocket taper bore over cone, aligning pull-up bolt holes with tapped holes in flange of clutch hub. Assemble pull-up bolts and lock washers.
- Tighten pull-up bolts ALTERNATELY and EVENLY. Do not use extensions on wrench handles. There should be a gap between the face of the sheave or sprocket hub and the flange of the clutch hub to insure a satisfactory cone grip and press fit. CAUTION: THIS GAP MUST NOT BE CLOSED.

TO DEMOUNT SHEAVE OR SPROCKET

- Loosen set screw in clutch hub and slide complete assembly from engine or motor shaft. If force is required, apply pressure to end of clutch hub only. DO NOT USE PULLER AT-TACHED TO SHEAVE, SPROCKET OR CLUTCH HOUSING.
- Remove pull-up bolts and screw two of them into threaded holes in sheave or sprocket and against flange of clutch hub.
 To break loose, tap end of clutch hub lightly with a soft headed mallet while maintaining back-off bolt pressure.




The Salsbury 600 Series Automatic Clutches are designed to operate on the following popular make gasoline engines within the speed range indicated. In each case the minimum and maximum operating speeds shown are within the operating speed range recommended by the engine manufacturer. To insure a long life of satisfactory service from both engine and clutch, drive should be designed for engine speeds within this range.

Release springs are provided in the clutch to insure load-free idling of the engine at or below the indicated maximum idling RPM.

The 600 Series will operate on other make engines not shown, provided their characteristics are comparable.




